Subject: Financial Management Modernization Initiative (FMFI) – Funded Program

PURPOSE

The purpose of this configuration decision is to provide USDA's policy on Funded Programs in FMFI.

DECISION

Funded Program is a master data element utilized to represent a program or project with a defined operational purpose and time frame for which a budget has been appropriated. A Funded Program enables FMFI users to record a budget, control postings, and monitor performance of sales orders. Funded Program is entered on a budget transaction and derived on commitment, obligations, cost and disbursement transactions. There is a one-to-one relationship between the Work Breakdown Structure (WBS) and Funded Program. The Funded Program structure is identical to the WBS Element.

A Funded Program will have a maximum of 24 alphanumeric characters, the structure is as follows:

- Position 1-2 = Agency Identifier
- Position 3-24 = Agency Defined Name
